## JRERE AVAILABLE ON DTIC

All back issues of the unclassified *Journal of Radiation Effects, Research and Engineering* (JRERE) are now available online at the Defense Technical Information Center (DTIC), a repository for research and engineering information for the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD).

## WHO CAN ACCESS DTIC?

- Authorized U.S. DoD/military employees
- Authorized U.S. Government employees
- Authorized U.S. Government Contractors and Subcontractors

## DTIC REQUIREMENTS

Access to DTIC's secured websites requires a valid DoD-recognized X.509 client certificate such as ONE of the following:

- DoD-issued Common Access Card (CAC)
- Personal Identity Verification (PIV) card
- External Certification Authority (ECA) card



## HOW TO REGISTER

Go to <https://reg.dtic.mil/DTICRegistration> and follow the instructions. For a detailed review of the instructions for each card type, see next page.



## REGISTER USING CAC, PIV, OR ECA

Go to the following webpage on DTIC:

<https://discover.dtic.mil/dtic-registration-benefits/dtic-registration/>. Click **Not registered yet?** below the **Login** button.

In the middle of the new page, note **How to Register** for each type of card.

**Note:** Contractors must use the Government Approving Officials (GAOs) listed on the registration page if they have a contract with one of the agencies listed.

### CAC card users:

Click the **Login/Register** button.

### PIV card users:

1. Load a \*DoD Root Certificate.
2. Go to <https://reg.dtic.mil/DTICRegistration> and click the **Smart Card** button.

### ECA card users:

1. Acquire an ECA card through an authorized ECA vendor such as **IdenTrust** at <https://identrust.com/certificates/eca/index.html> or **ORC** at <https://eca.orc.com/>.
2. Load a \*DoD Root Certificate.
3. Go to <https://reg.dtic.mil/DTICRegistration> and click the **Smart Card** button.

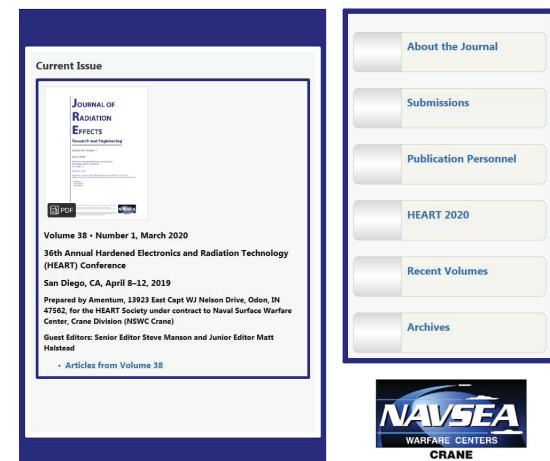
